WHAT IS PBIS?

PBIS stands for **P**ositive **B**ehavioral **I**nterventions and **S**upport. PBIS on the Bus is utilized as a proactive approach to bus discipline that emphasizes positive behaviors.

The foundations of PBIS include

- Teaching students the behaviors we expect to see.
- Reminding them to use those behaviors
- Acknowledging positive behaviors
- Correcting negative behaviors through reteaching.

When problem behaviors occur on the bus, the driver will complete a behavior form and re-teach appropriate behavior. All minor behavior incidents are addressed by the bus driver. All major behavior incidents are addressed by the school administration who will notify parents.

Fundamentals of PBIS on the Bus:

Be Responsible **Use Respect** **Stay Safe**

- Expected behaviors are taught to students by bus drivers.
- PBIS provides students with opportunities to practice appropriate behaviors in all areas of the bus.
- Positive behaviors are recognized, rewarded and celebrated on school campuses.
- Bus expectations are posted on the bus to remind students how to be responsible, respectful, and safe at all times.

BUS BUCKS

- Students receive individual tickets in recognition for using appropriate behavior on the bus. Bus Bucks are then collected by the classroom teacher and added to the student's buck's total. Each school uses these bucks in a different way, accepting them as they would their usual school tickets.
- Some schools have a school store where students can use their tickets as money to pay for small items.
- Other schools use their tickets to earn celebrations. Ask your students how their Bus Bucks and school tickets are used to celebrate their great positive behaviors at school and on the bus!
