

Dear Incoming TK Families,

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year! We are very excited about your child's first experience in our school and want to let you know of several details that will ensure a successful transition into our routines.

First Day Schedule- This is for Monday only

8:25 Line up at the Kinder Playground (gated)- I will meet you there!
(If your child wants breakfast, please enter through the main gate from 8-8:15)
8:30-9:30 School Begins- ONE parent or guardian accompanies student for a short orientation and welcome craft in the classroom. **Please bring a 4x6 family photo.**
9:30 Parents say goodbye!

12:30 Dismissal (pick up your student at the side gate next to the Kinder playground at the top of the stairs off Sunset Lane)

Please do not plan for more than one adult to accompany your student. The classroom is not big enough for more bodies. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Lunch/Snacks-

It will help us if you spend some time talking to your child about what they are eating at school. They will have a recess/snack break and a lunch break daily. They will bring their snacks into the classroom and leave their lunch pails outside on the hooks. If your child has a lunch from home, please let them put it in their own backpack so they know there is a lunch there for them. **Your students have the option to bring a lunch from home or get a school lunch- more info will be given about school lunches at orientation.** Students need both a snack AND a lunch everyday.

****Also, at this time, please do NOT send any student supplies for the classroom. We will still need items from the TK supply list but not until a later time as there is no place to house new items at this time. The only items your child will need is a full size child's backpack, please no preschool (the little ones) backpacks as we send home folders and they don't fit into that size backpack as well as a lunch pail and water bottle. Please label every item with your child's name.**

In the event that your child has a hard time saying goodbye to you at 9:30, please know that we are prepared to help in that transition and have found most students are able to adjust after you have left.
