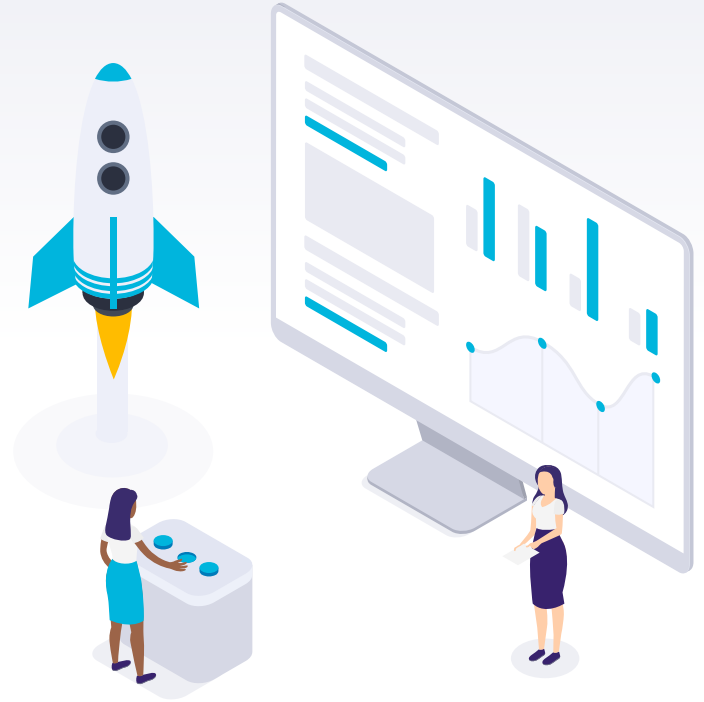

**BACKGROUND**

On Friday, March 13, 2020, Riverside County Health Department closed all schools in Riverside County until April 6, 2020. On Tuesday, March 17, 2020, this school closure was extended until at least April 30, 2020. As a result, CVUSD has had to develop and implement plans to address such challenges as providing distance enrichment learning to our nearly 18,000 TK-12 grade students, ensuring our students receive breakfast and lunch daily, ensuring the maintenance of cleaning our school and district sites, and maintaining the business infrastructure of our district.

On March 17, 2020 California education and health officials released new guidance for K-12 schools to help education leaders meet the needs of all students affected by school closures, with an emphasis on assisting low-income children and those with disabilities.

This guidance follows Governor Gavin Newsom's March 13 [Executive Order](#), which ensured that schools continue to receive funding and outlined key efforts that schools should pursue, including educational opportunities via distance learning


