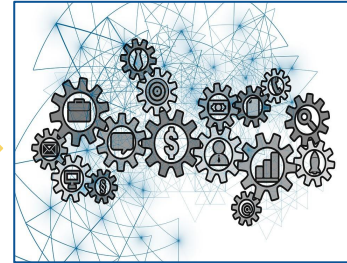
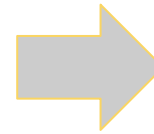

# Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)

- **The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a requirement of LCFF Funding.**
- LCFF funds every student in California at the same *base rate*, but districts receive varying amounts of additional funding based upon:
  - The number of students from the following target groups (*supplemental funding*):
    - **English Learners**
    - **Foster Youth**
    - **Low-Income Students**
  - Whether or not one or more of the above groups represent 55% or more of students in the district (*concentration funding-FSD not eligible*)

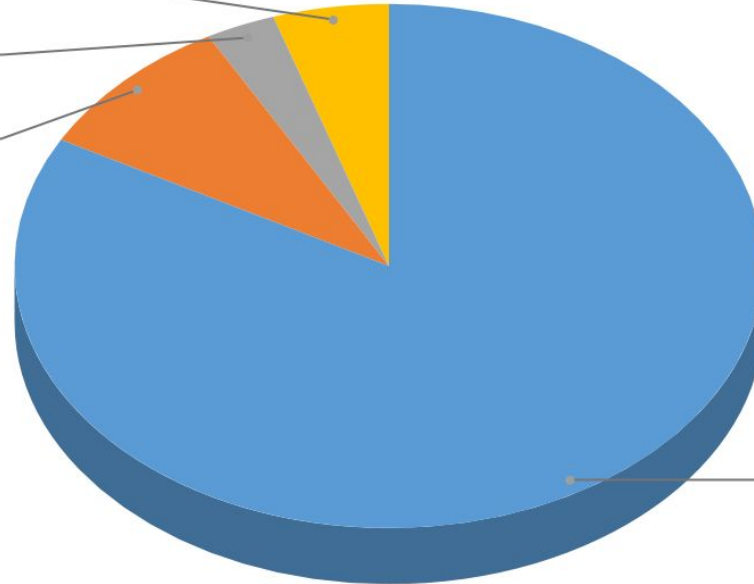

# Key LCFF Requirements

**Engage stakeholders**  
in the development of a **strategic plan**  
that explains how the district will use this funding  
to **address 8 state priorities**  
and **report on annual progress** toward meeting those priorities.

This plan is called the  
**Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)**

LCAP goals, actions, and expenditures must be aligned to one or  
more of the 8 state priorities.

# LCFF Supplemental Funding 2021-2022

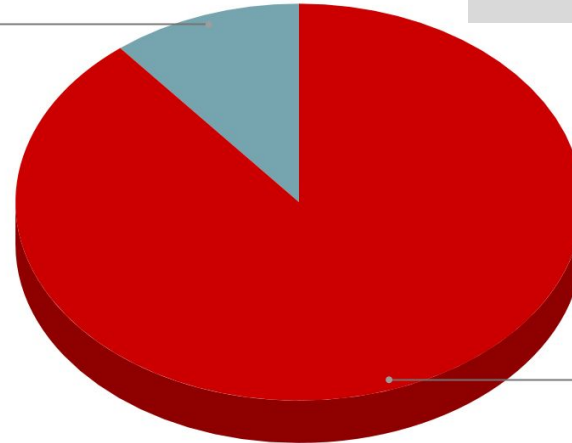
Districts must demonstrate that Supplemental Funding helps **Increase and/or Improve Services** for the students for which it receives the supplemental funding:

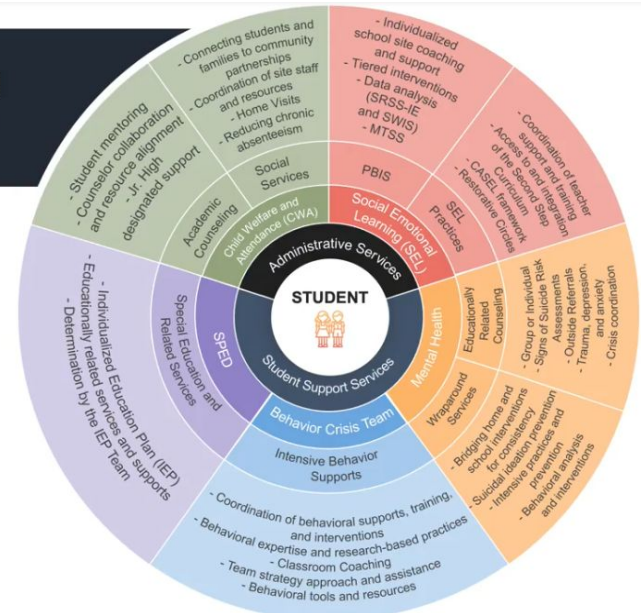

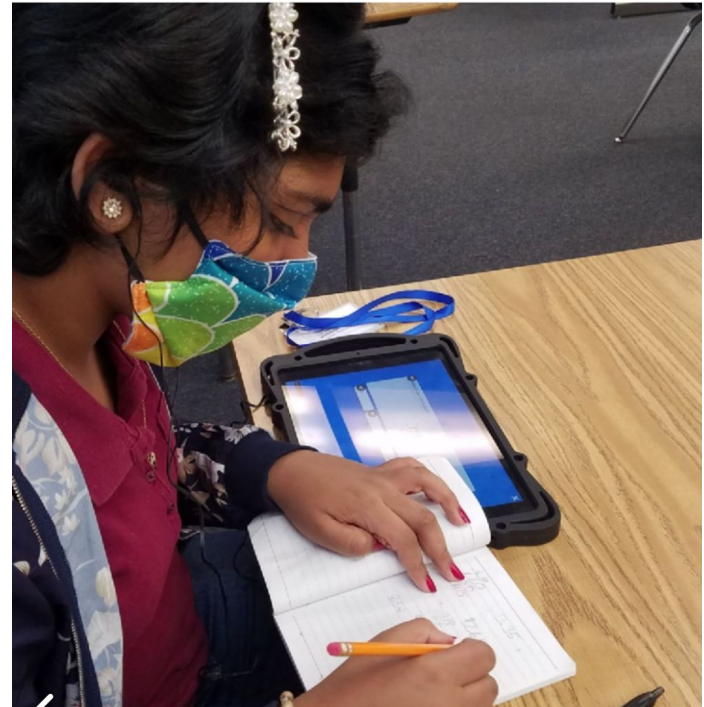

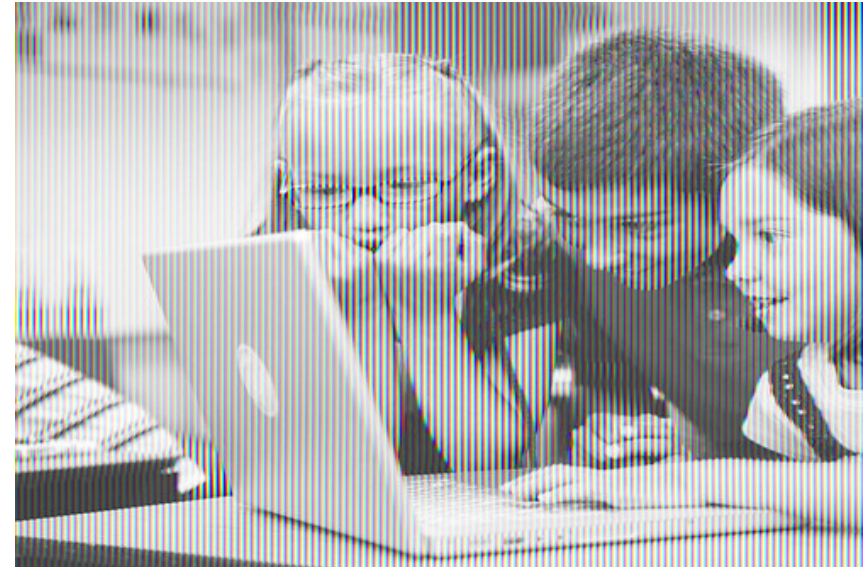
