Once students show proficiency in reading, writing, speaking and listening in English measured by the ELPAC, a mid-point score within the basic level on district ELA benchmark assessment, and teacher evaluation, the student will be reclassified as R-FEP (Reclassified Fluent English Proficient). ELAC is the advisory committee that advises administrators and staff on services for English learners, assists with the School Site Council and attends SSC meetings, assists with school and district needs, and assists with parent awareness.
