The meeting was called to order at 8:22 a.m. by Dr. Erlinda Ruiz (Principa), who welcomed all ELAC members.

Summary of Discussion/Action(s) Taken:

- LCAP- Mrs. Hermelinda is our representative for LCAP at the district
 - There are 8 priorities: Conditions of Learning, Pupil Outcomes, and Engagements
 - Funds get disbursed: 83% salaries and benefits, 10% Instructional Materials, 4% Professional Development, 6% Operations & Services
 - Health Nurse, Dual Immersion, RTI Teachers
 - LCAP Survey is still open
 - Suggestions from last year were shown
- Guest Speaker- Orange County Department of Education: Michel Chavez
 - Adolescents brain takes 25 years to develop
 - Risk factors for why they use drugs or alcohol: Peer Pressure, No supervision, no consequences, easily accessible, social norms.
 - E-Cigs: Contains nicotine, easy to hide, nice flavors. Inhalers, pod watch.
 - Nicotine in Adolescents: affects learning, focus, depression
 - Signals of use: low grades, change of friends & behaviors, sleeping habits, isolated
 - How can you help: manage stress and emotions, keep positive during meal times, communication, clear risks, disapprove drugs, give examples
