The meeting was called to order at 3:02 pm by Dr. Erlinda Ruiz (Principal), who welcomed all School Site Council representatives.

Introductions: Parents, Teachers, SSA, and administrators introduced themselves

New Business:

- Dr. Ruiz welcomed the team to SSC and discussed the roles and responsibilities of each member that participates in SSC
 - o Ensure school plan is working in the proper order- everyone's input is valuable
 - Make decisions on how school monies will be distributed and spent
 - Decision making-voting group
 - Monthly meetings (6-8 meetings in the school year)
 - Review student achievement, develop a plan for students, ongoing review of programs in place for students, review input from other groups, bring recommendations to the board
 - 5 parents / 5 staff members
 - o Chairperson-Jocelyn Siverio
- School Reopening of COVID
 - Parents will receive videos of procedures/protocols of school safety. Videos will be in English/Spanish. Topics include: temperature checks and home, classroom cleaning procedures
 - Wellness Room will address low-risk and high risk symptoms
 - Parents will be notified and certain steps will be taken to ensure that students are taken care of
 - School map
 - 3 different entrances (Gate#1 -K-2nd thermal camera, Gate #2-3rd & 4th , Gate #3-5th &6th)
 - If temperature is high→ hydration station (MPR) to cool off.
 - If temperature remains high → wellness room
 - If temperature cools down → students go to classroom

- 5 day students not with teacher will be in rooms
- Lanyards will be sent home with Cohort A/Cohort B
- New Bell Schedule
 - Everyone starts at 8:15
 - Kindergarten-180 minutes, 11:30 dismissal
 - 1st-3rd-230 minutes, 1:05 virtual ends, 2:05 dismissal
 - 4th-6th-240 minutes, 1:15 virtual ends, 2:15 dismissal
- o Scheduled book drop off/ information pickup for students the week of October 5th
 - Maps, calendar, lanyards

Action Items:

- SSC ByLaws-will discuss at the next meeting. Group was ok to move item to next meeting

Summary of Discussion/Action(s) Taken:

- School Plan-this year the format of school plan has been modified. Dr. Ruiz went over the components of the school plan (Goals, data, what programs are implemented, who's responsible for this, and how it is going to be paid?)
 - New(simplified chart): Access, instruction, participation and engagement, attendance, staff training, interventions, SEL/mental health services, parent outreach, transition strategies from preschool to kindergarten
 - Once the plan is created, SSC will approve and SSC chairperson will sign on behalf of the Valencia's SSC

Public Input/Advice: Comments/Questions/Advisement

- More lunch tables for social distancing? Yes, different cohorts will eat in different sections of campus. Additional tables have been added to the main eating area and kinder lunch area. Sitting spots are placed on the benches.
- What are the 5 day students doing? Students are going to be zooming with classroom teachers. They will follow the same schedule as the in class students
- When are we going to revisit this school schedule? Depending on the COVID situation. The safety/cleaning protocols will continue to be in place to keep COVID cases down
- Do we have resources for families that test positive? We have clinics that have low cost, will send information with resources to families,
- What if one student tests positive in my child's classroom? Parents will be notified, and tracking
 will be done to see how much exposure has taken place. The district does have a protocol in
