SUBJECT: APPROVE INITIAL CONTRACT PROPOSAL FROM THE FULLERTON
SCHOOL DISTRICT TO FULLERTON ELEMENTARY TEACHERS
ASSOCIATION (FETA)

Background: Government Code Section 3547 requires that all initial proposals of exclusive representative and public school employers relating to matters within the scope of representation be presented at a public meeting. Proposals become public record once they are presented (“sunshined”).

Meeting and negotiating shall not take place on any proposal until a reasonable time has elapsed after the submission of the proposal to enable the public to become informed and the public has held the opportunity to express itself regarding the proposal at a Board meeting.

A copy of the Fullerton School District proposal is available for review in the Superintendent’s office.

Funding: Not applicable.
