COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Relations Between Private Industry and the Schools

The Board of Trustees recognizes that private industry is an important segment of the local community and that the District should seek the involvement and support of representatives from private industry. The participation of private industry in the schools can add to the District's commitment to prepare students for entry into the business community.

The Superintendent is encouraged to promote Adopt-a-School partnerships between the schools and private industry by establishing regulations governing the development and operation of such partnerships. The major emphasis in such partnerships is on the utilization of human resources, not on the donation of funds. Activities appropriate to these partnerships include career education, incentive and recognition programs, classroom assistance and tutoring, technical education, and staff development.

The Superintendent shall periodically report to the Board regarding relations between private industry and the schools.
