

COMMUNITY RELATIONSSchool-Based Coordinated Programs

The Governing Board recognizes the advantages of greater flexibility and coordination in the use of categorical funds. Each school site may choose to be school-based coordinated under the School-Based Coordination Act of 1981.

The site principals shall be provided with information regarding school-based coordinated programs. They will provide such information to the School Site Council for consideration. Interested persons including, but not limited to, the principal, teachers, or other school personnel, and parents will have an opportunity to meet in public to establish a school-based coordinated program.

State categorical funds that are to be coordinated will be used to supplement, not supplant, existing state and local fiscal efforts. Schools which receive the funds shall have base expenditures comparable to non participating schools.

Procedures affecting school-based coordinated programs are found in EC 52800.
